

Temperature Correction for Maple Sap Hydrometers

Maple <u>Sap hydrometers</u> are generally calibrated for 38 degrees F if you are testing sap that is warmer than 38 degrees F you will need to make the following adjustments to your reading.

32-46°F, no correction needed.

47-56°F, add 0.1 brix to measurement

57-61°F, add 0.2 brix to measurement

62-64°F, add 0.3 brix to measurement

65-68°F, add 0.4 brix to measurement

69-72°F, add 0.5 brix to measurement

73-75°F, add 0.6 brix to measurement
